CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- The students will not disturb the scholastic vibes of the campus by noisy or uncalled for behavior.
- The students will always carry with them college identity card and will humbly produce it whenever asked by the authority to prove their legitimacy.
- 3. The students will not have loose walk entry into any office, department, library, principal's office etc. They must first seek the permission by stating their official/ personal work before entering.
