The scope and responsibilities of Unfair Means Investigation Committee include but not limited to the following.

Scope of the Committee.

Unfair Means resorted to by the students.


Responsibilities of the committee includes but not limited to the following.

- To conduct systematic and procedural investigation into the matter related to unfair means and malpractices.
- Strict adherence to the code of conduct as laid down in Maharashtra Prevention of Malpractices at University, Board, and other specified examination Act 1982.
- The UMIC shall remain present on a date, time & place fixed for the meeting by CoE.
- The Unfairmeans Investigation Committee will function as an enquiring and re-commendatory body and submit its recommendations in the form of a report to the Chairman of EC through CoE.
- The committee shall investigate the matter related with Unfairmeans of the reported cases of the students, as per the provisions made in Clause and its sub- clauses of exam related ordinances, rules and regulations.
- Reasonable opportunity, including oral hearing shall be given to the Examinees in his defense before the Committee. The reply / explanation given by the Examinees shall be considered by the Committee before making final recommendations in the case.

- g. If student fails to appear before the committee, the Committee shall take decision in his case in his absentia, on the basis of the available evidence / documents which shall be binding on the student concerned.
- h. The Committee shall work in the spirit of the principles of natural justice.
- i. The Committee shall submit its report to the EC through CoE along with its recommendation regarding punishment to be imposed or otherwise.
- j. Approved recommendations will be notified by CoE on behalf of Chairman EC.
- k. The tenure of the committee shall be two years.
