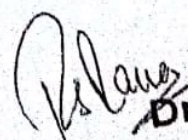
The below mentioned modules are the outcome of detailed study of industry and current situation of students in various fields of engineering.

**Duration :**

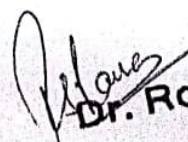
30 hours sessions on all 11 sections of first semester 2 hours a week.
