Like a magic wosh!

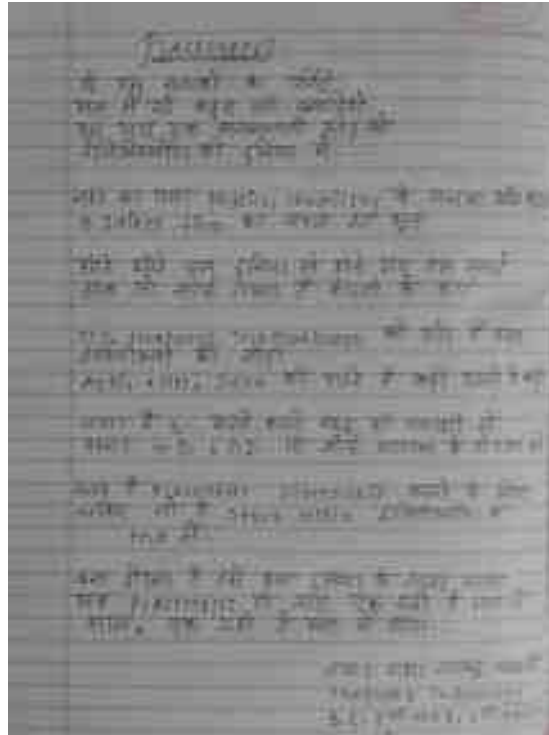
December was on full swing

Head hung and covered with a hood.

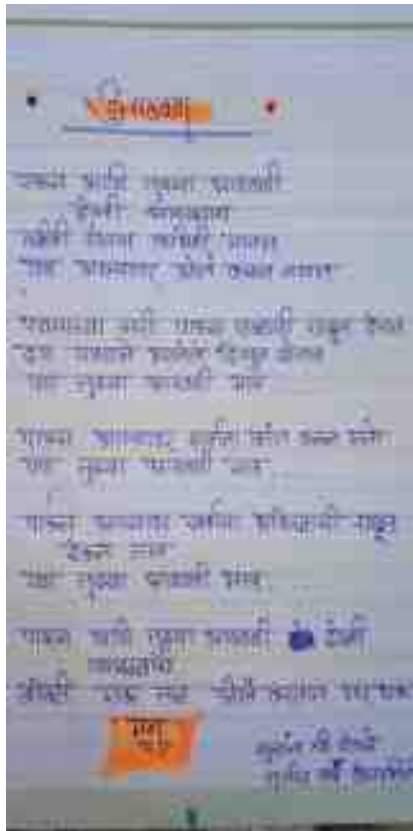
Everyone was busy

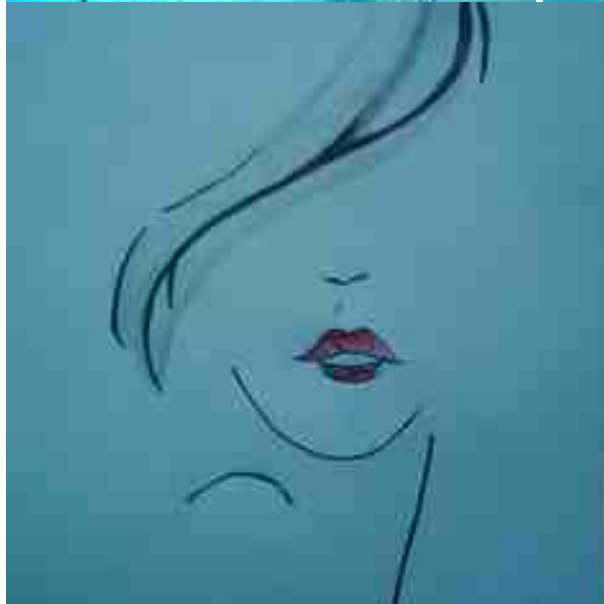
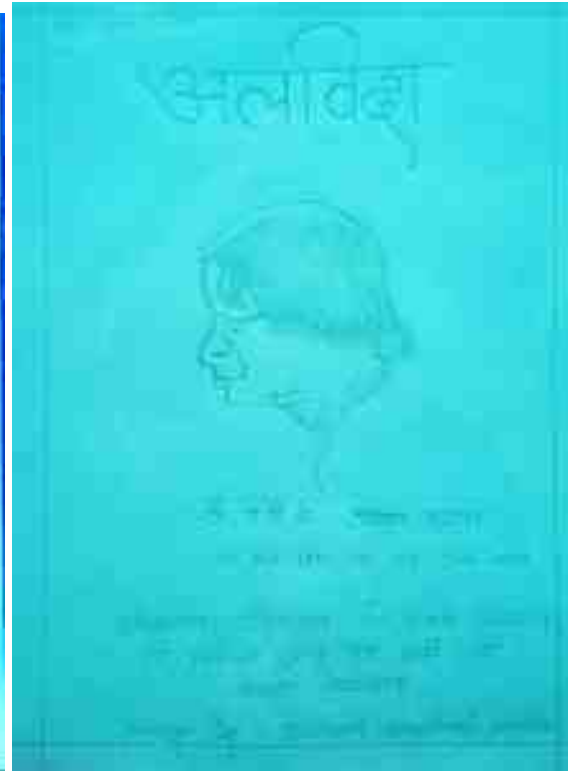

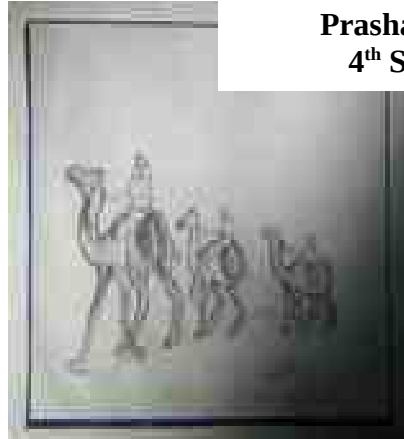
